

### Talk Time Guidelines:

These are the guidelines and procedures we will follow:

- Meet in public place or with more than you and the student.
- We will avoid overnights except as a group.
- Volunteers will provide a copy of their Drivers License and References.
- Only Approved Drivers will be allowed to pick students up and take them home.
- There should be an experienced Talk Time Discussion Leader at each table. Newer volunteers will be sent to one of these tables to be mentored.
- There should be two Americans at each table.

### Talk Time GOALS:

Individual volunteers develop personal relationships with internationals to lead them to Christ, help them grow, and help them to return home to their country well prepared.

### Talk Time ACTIVITIES to achieve the goals:

- Talk Time
- Meet with international student outside of Talk Time, in a public place.
- Special events like the Hoe-down, Talk Time Christmas Party, Mt. Baker Ski Retreat, Peak Adventures, Tulip Trip, and Mt. Rainier.
- RJC for your own training (and perhaps theirs, if they are a new believer or seeker.)
- Hosting international students through an agency such as ICC, ABODE, EdCC, or USA International.
- Visiting returnees in Japan and elsewhere to see how they're doing.

### Essentials for FRUITFUL INVOLVEMENT:

- Willingness to develop a personal friendship with at least one international each year.
- Willingness to maintain long distance relationships with returnee internationals.
- Attendance at Talk Time on some recurrent basis.
- Assist with other necessities as possible (e.g. transportation, conversation, event coordination, food)
- Rotate TT logistical responsibilities among other volunteers.
- Pray together for what we want to see happen.
